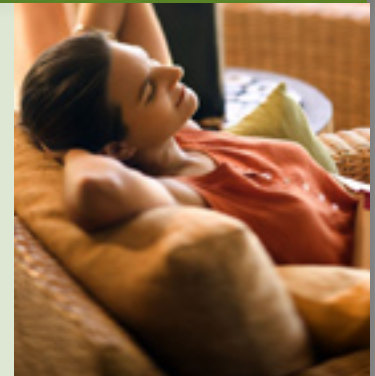

SKIP-A - PAYMENT COMING SOON

As a benefit of membership, your Fairfield Federal Credit Union invites you to relax and take a loan payment break. It's easy to "Skip" your loan payment!

Skip-A-Payment requests are based on approval criteria established by the Fairfield Federal Credit Union. A fee of \$25.00 or 10% of loan payment, whichever is greater, must be paid at time the request is processed. Acceptance of this offer will extend the term of the loan and interest will continue to accrue. Members whom are currently delinquent, had previous delinquencies in the past 12 months, or any other extensions in the past 12 months with the credit union will not qualify for this offer. A maximum of one payment per loan in a 12-month period may be skipped. This service is subject to change without notice and other restrictions may apply. Mortgage and home equity loans are excluded from this program.
